

KEEP OUT ICEBERGS.

Mr. Lewis Suggests Damming Belle Isle Passage to Protect Gulf.

(Canadian Press Despatch.)

Ottawa, Feb. 26.—E. N. Lewis West Huron, gives notice of a resolution in House of Commons in favor of blocking the straits of Belle Isle to keep icebergs out of the Gulf of St. Lawrence. He sets forth that as the straits at their narrowest point are only ten miles wide, the rocky shores could be quarried and the straits dammed. The labor of criminals, tramps and interned **alien enemies** is suggested for the work.
