

ATTEMPT TO BLOW UP A SUBWAY AT BRANTFORD.

Brantford, March 1.—Sunday morning an attempt to blow up the Elgin street subway, near the railway station here, was discovered. J. Miller, a local oil dealer, returning from a visit to his barns, found two cans, subsequently discovered to have contained explosives, lying between the rails. The cans were connected with lengths of insulated copper wire, which the passing of a train due soon would sever, thus exploding the contents of the cans. The police arrested an Austrian found hiding in the yards of the Keetin, Automobile Company.
