
INTERPRETER TOOK MONEY FROM ALIENS REGISTERING

EXACTED FEES AND IN SOME
CASES FRIGHTENED THEM
WITH INTERNMENT.

Ottawa, March 4.—John Martin, Austrian interpreter in the alien enemy registration office here, was found guilty to-day of collecting money from aliens under false pretences. He was remanded for sentence. It was shown that he had exacted fees for registrations, and in some cases taken money from foreigners on the ground that otherwise they would be interned. He pocketed the money.

"MORE DAYLIGHT" MAN DEAD.

William Willett, Whose Proposals Attracted Great Attention.
