

ENEMY ALIENS AT PORCUPINE.

Disquieting conditions exist in the Porcupine district, according to the Porcupine Herald, owing to the presence of large numbers of alien enemies. The foreign population there is stated to far outnumber the British, and the latter have become so disturbed owing to various occurrences that they have organized themselves into a Home Guard to defend themselves, if need be, not against an outside invasion, but against a local majority of alien enemies.

Details are given of the arrest of Austrians found engaged in military drill, and of the arrest of Germans charged with stealing dynamite from the Nipissing mine and attempting to blow up a magazine containing 129 cases of dynamite. The further statement is made that alien enemies employed in the mines every month send some \$40,000 or \$50,000 to German bankers in New York to be forwarded to Austria and Germany.
