

DRESDEN'S CREW IN CANADA

Taken to a Point in Maritime Provinces And Closely Guarded.

A Toronto man, just back from the Maritime Provinces brings news of the fate of Germans captured aboard the Dresden. These were taken to Halifax, and, with Germans taken from other ships—300 in all—were taken to an old factory at a point in the Maritime Provinces surrounded with swamps. Their prison is enclosed by six rows of barb wire entanglements with 2,000 volts of electricity passing through them.
