

## GERMANS IN CANADA CELEBRATE VICTORY AND THEN ARRESTED

Vancouver, B. C., April 30.—Four prominent German residents of Vancouver were arrested today, charged with taking part last Sunday night with a number of other Germans in a celebration of the German victory

over Canadian troops in Ypres. A long list of Vancouver men killed and wounded reached here Sunday night and news of the celebration caused popular indignation. The Germans arrested declare they were merely having a house warming, the party having been arranged several days previously. It is expected that the man will be sent to a detention camp.
