

EMPLOYEES QUIT WORK.

Aliens Not Released by Great West Saddlery Company at Calgary.

Calgary, Alta., May 17.—In accordance with an ultimatum delivered last week about sixty employees of the Great West Saddlery company today threw down their tools and refused to work because the firm had not released several alleged Germans and Austrians as demanded.

It is alleged that the committee of the employees was not courteously treated by the management when it went to the office to ask what was the intension respecting the naturalized aliens employed. This precipitated matters, and 20 per cent, of the staff left the shop. At a meeting held subsequently it was decided to lay their position before R. B. Bennett, M.P., and if necessary to wire Ottawa.
