

Anti-German Feeling Growing.

Toronto, May 18.—The anti-German sentiment in Toronto is becoming more acute. Today the city council revoked a permit for a large electric sign advertising beers with German names, although they are brewed in Canada by Canadian citizens. The sign, it is stated, cost \$20,000. Instructions were also sent to heads of departments to discharge employees of German and Austrian birth. Wm.

Kraussman, a native-born Canadian, announced that owing to criticisms he would sell his filly, Hampton Dame, which was entered for the King's Plate.
