

## CITIZEN MAKES DISCLOSURE.

Wrote Alien Registrar in Regard to  
George Harmann, Interned.

Evidence substantiating the fact that George Harmann, 78 Wilson avenue, who on Saturday was sent to the **internment** camp, is where he ought to be, was received by the Registrar of Aliens to-day. It consists of the statement of a responsible citizen, who is well acquainted with Harmann and his affairs, which shows that while Harmann's salary from the firm he represented was between \$25 and \$30 weekly; his living expenses were in no way curtailed, and he always spent money freely. It further states that Harmann, while travelling extensively about the country, ostensibly in connection with his position of traveller for the firm of Lazarus, Rosenfeld and Co., always carried with him a camera and field glasses. These were freely used and the registrar's informant also tells that some time before the war, Harmann admitted to him that he was forwarding photographs to Germany. It is thought probable that his wife, who is an Englishwoman, was ignorant of her husband's connection with the Fatherland, as he passed himself off here as a Swiss. She has a brother serving in the British army.
