

ALL WANDERERS TO BE INTERNED

Carrying Major McLeod, chief intelligence officer, and a detachment from the 44th Battalion, a special train left here this afternoon to round up a number of Germans and Austrians wandering over the prairies between here and Emerson.

Last week more than 1,500 of them left Winnipeg to enter the states. Their number soon dwindled until they reached Emerson, where there were less than 200 in the band. Yesterday these were interned at Brandon and now the balance are being caught and sent down to the intern camp.
