More Austrians Interned - The second "army" of Austrians, which left Winnipeg on Tuesday with the object of crossing into the United States, has been rounded up by the militia and sent to Brandon, where they will be maintained at the expense of the Canadian government until after the war. There were 258 members of the party rounded up yesterday, and it is expected that a number of stragglers will still be encountered. Some of the stragglers of the first army are said to have eluded the vigilance of the United States officers and to have crossed the line at a point some distance from Emerson,
