

AUSTRIAN HELD MEETINGS

In Union Stock Yards and Read Austrian Papers to Aliens.

Dan Wozny, a 20-year-old Austrian, was interned by Mr. J. Russell Snow on Monday on evidence that Wozny, who has been employed as a car cleaner in the Union Stock Yards, has been gathering mass meetings of Austrians at noon hour, and reading German and Austrian newspapers to them, generally inciting rebellion.

"The stampede of 2,000 horses from the Stock Yards last fall has never been explained," commented Mr. Snow.

John Dietz, the German-American, employed up to Friday last by the Russell Motor Car Company, who was brought up for using pro-German and offensive language to citizens on the street, was let go.

"I was never in Germany, and my father cast his first vote in America for Abe Lincoln, the first time he ran," said Dietz. "I was drunk when I spoke, and I deeply regret it."
