

REMOVAL OF TURKISH PRISONERS

Captain Cameron and a strong guard of the 44th, and the military interpreter, in a special car, took a large number of Turkish and German prisoners of war to Toronto this morning, where they will be confined to Stanley Barracks and then distributed among the various detention camps.

There were 29 prisoners, 25 of them Turks and four Germans. Among the German prisoners was a doctor and a wealthy merchant. They seemed to take their imprisonment calmly.
