

ITALIAN RESERVISTS IN THE SAULT ARE ORDERED TO ITALY

Local Italian Consul Received
Instructions to That Effect
Last Night

600 RESIDE IN THE
SAULT AT PRESENT

Date of Departure not yet
Announced, but Will be
in Few Days

Instructions from the Royal Italian Consular Agent at Montreal were received by the local Italian Consul Mr. Wm. Grassi yesterday to prepare for the return to Italy of all reservists between the ages of 20 and 39 years. These men, of whom there are about 600 in the Sault, will be instructed as to the time of departure in a few days, and all expenses will be ultimately settled by the Italian Government.

It will be remembered that the Canadian Government announced some days ago that free transportation to Italy would be provided by the Canadian Government for all Italians who desired to rejoin and participate in the war.

At all probability the Italian colony here will engage in a suitable demonstration when the men leave. The date is not known as yet.
