

INTERN ALIENS AT THE SEWELL MILILARY CAMP SUGGESTS MAYOR CATER

Prisoners Making Dash for Liberty Given Short Jail Terms— Wounded Man Recovering

To take the eight hundred or more interned aliens from the winter fair arena and place them under guards at Sewell is the suggestion of Mayor Cater, arising out of the trouble on Saturday night. His worship thinks the men should be removed from the city.

All of the men who were caught before they could get away and were not injured, were before Col. Clark yesterday. Terms varying from three months to one month at the provincial jail were meted out to them. They were charged under the head of damaging government property and attempting to escape. The man who was shot will probably recover and the other man will leave the hospital in a day or two.
