

# Nerlich Case to Go on To-Morrow

*Accused in Court, To-day Re-  
news Heavy Bail—Does  
Not Plead*

Mr. Emil Nerlich appeared in the Assize Court to-day. His bail was renewed and the case was adjourned until to-morrow. Mr. Justice Sutherland was on the bench, Mr. R. H. Greer, County Crown Attorney, appeared for the Crown, and Mr. G. W. Mason for the accused.

At the opening of court Mr. Greer rose to say that Mr. Nerlich had not yet pleaded to his indictment, but that his counsel was anxious that he should not plead to-day, he supposed on formal grounds.

The case had been adjourned till to-day, but he understood that a re-arrangement had been made for the case to stand over until to-morrow for trial. He proposed that bail be arranged and the court be formally adjourned until to-morrow. He understood that Mr. W. C. Mikel, K.C., and his Lordship had consented to this arrangement.

His Lordship acquiesced, though he said it was a little awkward for the jurors. Still that had been arranged. He directed that the court be adjourned until 10 o'clock to-morrow.

Mr. Emil Nerlich and his brother, Henry, advanced and renewed their bonds of \$50,000 each.

The court was then adjourned.

Mr. W. C. Mikel, K.C., Crown counsel, arrived from Belleville to-day to conduct the case for the Crown.
