

REFUSE TO ENTER MINES WITH ALIENS

British Workmen at Fernie Mines Decline to Work With Austrians and Germans.

FERNIE, B. C., June 8.—Trouble has arisen owing to British miners refusing to work underground with Austrian and German miners. The shifts this morning turned out, but those of allied nationality repeated their demands made yesterday that aliens should be excluded. The management argued that the matter should be taken up through the government, but the men remained obdurate and were then granted an idle day to endeavor to arrange a settlement among themselves. A mass meeting is to be held this afternoon.
