

ORDER GIVEN FOR MORE RECRUITING

Mounted Corps Will be Strengthened — Many Vancouver Names in Casualty Lists.

Instructions have been received for the recruiting of more men in Vancouver for the 11th Canadian Mounted Rifles, who are training at Vernon camp. Recruits, it is understood, will be taken on at the local depot of the 72nd Highlanders.

Recruiting has also opened at Langley and Abbotsford for the 30th B. C. Horse, which regiment will be recruited further for the purpose of guard duty at the Vernon internment camp. Men desiring to join this force should be able to ride and must make application at the depots in the centres mentioned. They will not be taken on at Vancouver.

Lieutenant-Colonel W. M. Davis, commanding the 54th Battalion, has received orders to have a company of 255 officers and men ready for active service within three weeks. It is understood that a company will also be drafted from the 48th Battalion for the front.
