INTERNES TO WORK The interned enemies in the province are not to be allowed to pass

their time in unemployed captivity and live on the people, but they are to be put to work that will benefit the

province. The internes from Lethbridge, it is said, are to be moved to Banff, and set to work on the motor road running

through the Rocky Mountain Park which forms a part of the highway scheme from Winnipeg to the coast, down to California and back to Win-

nigeg. The camps for the men will be

situated betweed Castle and Banff. and the men, of whom there are expected to be from 80 to 100, will be moved in the course of a day or so.
