

To Seek Spies In All Parts Of Ontario

Ottawa, June 24.—"We have enough troops under arms at London, Niagara, Barrie and other parts of Canada to discourage any attempt at invasion of Canada at any point by any armed parties of Germans or Austrians from the United States," declared an official of the Militia Department this morning, discussing the uneasiness at various points in Ontario in this regard, following the dynamiting of the Peabody factory and the attempts at the Windsor and Meaford armories.

It was learned, however, that the militia authorities had taken special precautions at all points to guard factories where spies might slip in and do untold damage to workers and munitions with explosives.
