

ALIENS CLEAR LAND

Two Thousand Acres Stripped of Forest in Northern Ontario.

Ottawa, June 19.—The two thousand odd alien enemies entered in the big concentration camps at Kapuscasung and Spirit Lake, in Northern Ontario and Quebec, have already cleared about 1000 acres of good arable land at each camp, and the government has now set aside another 2,000 acres at each point for further clearing. Part of the land is being cropped this year, and by next year it is expected there will be a considerable settlement in the districts, and, as a result of the war, two new towns will spring up along the National Transcontinental.
