

ARRESTED FOR TREASON

Germans Who Have Lived 30 Years In Canada Accused.

Vancouver, B. C., July 14.—Two farmers, Ernest Hamel and David Kitzel, have been arrested here on a charge of high treason. They are German-born, but have lived in Canada for more than thirty years, and long ago became citizens of the British Empire.

It is alleged that in April they committed treason by assisting two Germans named Keppel and Secord to escape from British Columbia across the boundary into the United States and to Germany.
