

Local Internment Camp Being Rapidly Depleted

The internment camp at Lethbridge is being rapidly depleted. Today it is but a shadow of its former self. Last week 120 of the internees were taken to Banff where they are being put to work on government roads. Today 80 more are being taken north, and this has necessitated the dismissal,

temporarily at least, of 15 or more of the guards.

It is understood that it is not the intention to do away with the camp altogether, and it is likely that the 105 odd internees remaining at Fernie will be sent here. In the meantime, the camp has an almost deserted appearance.
