

# UNCOVER PLOT AT DETROIT FOR SHIPPING OF ALLIENS

Treason Charges May be Laid  
Against Windsor Officers — Boat  
Load Said to Have Passed.

Windsor, Ont., July 21.—Sensational charges of treason which will implicate and cause the arrest of several men prominent in the affairs of Windsor are looked for within the next few days, the result of investigation conducted jointly by the United States and Canadian Immigration Departments. It was reported on good authority that the net which is being drawn by the Immigration Department of both countries will catch certain officers of Windsor. Whether these men are civil or government officers cannot be learned.

William Lonney, alias "Shrump" Lonney, and Max Laker, were arrested Saturday on charges of treason, are but small fish," to quote an official compared to the men who will be held. It was positively asserted These men are both charged with smuggling alien enemies of Canada

into the United States, but their positions are said to have been on a small scale in comparison to the work done by others and with the knowledge of certain men whose duty it was to apprehend the smugglers and those being smuggled.

It is stated that a big freighter took on several alien enemies of Great Britain at Windsor and landed them at a port in the United States without having them go through the necessary inspections by immigrant inspectors. The captain of the ship will, it is understood, be arrested at the first opportunity.

Police officials and immigrant inspectors in Windsor are reticent about their operations concerning investigations of charges of treason, but it has been learned on good authority that a surprise that will stir the border city and perhaps the entire Dominion from end to end may be looked for.
