

## Turks Most Troublesome.

The camp consists of a row of tar-papered one-story shacks, set in the middle of a large clearing. Here approximately a thousand Austrians and Turks are gathered. There are only about a hundred and fifty of the latter, but they cause more trouble than all the rest put together. Their pet foible is to refuse to work. When that happens they are made to work. This system of compulsion, we are told, is a deep, dark secret in which not even the officers of the camp share. Suffice it to say that invariably the Turks do work, sooner or later.

At one time or another a few of the prisoners have escaped from the camp, but none of them enjoyed more than a few hours of freedom. Without exception they have been rounded up and returned to camp Kanuskasing.
