establishment, and that after such appointment no literature is to be issued until cens red. The printing of any news concerning war movements or operations or criticizing or commenting upon the policy, proceedings or action of the

Government of any neutral state, if such would interfere with the success of the allied forces or prejudice allied relations, will be deemed a controvention of the censorship order. Prosecution is to be taken by the At-

torney-General of Canada. A fine not exceeding \$5,000 and imprisonment not exceeding two years is provided for conviction or indictment, and forsummary conviction a fine not ex-

ceeding \$2,000 and imprisonment not exceeding six months. Publication by offending establishments may also be suspended indefinitely at the will of the Secretary of State, under whom

censorship will be exercised.
