

NOT RISKING INTERNMENT

Mr. Bischoff Refuses to Come to Montreal

Mr. Rudolph Bischoff is an Austrian, formerly of Montreal, where he was manager of the Ritz-Carlton Hotel, but now, owing to the war, residing in New York. Mr. Leon Garneau, K.C., applied to Mr. Justice Lane in the Practice Court yesterday to have him examined in New York, as Mr. Bischoff, by reason of his nationality, fears to come here without a safe conduct, and Mr. Garneau wishes to secure his evidence in an action brought by the Ritz-Carlton Hotel against L. N. Patenaude, who is being sued for amounts alleged due in connection with the newsstand at the hotel, which Patenaude operated. Mr. Garneau, who is acting for Mr. Patenaude, stated to the court that he had endeavored to get from Mr. C. G. Ogden, registrar of alien enemies, a safe conduct so that Mr. Bischoff might come here but had been unsuccessful. Mr. Ogden refusing to give a guarantee. Mr. Justice Lane will give judgment next Friday.
