The strike among the prisoners at Petawawa military camp came to an abrupt end on Friday last and peace and harmony prevail again. The bread and water diet and the depriving of the strikers of their tobacco, together with the drill routine to which they were subjected, had a wholesome effect upon the discontented ones, while Rev. Father Biernacki, who was summoned from Barry's Bay by Col. de la Ronde to use his influence with the prisoners, gave them some plain talk and some sound advice. which also proved very effective.
