JUST GOING TO THRASH HIM.

Soldier Acquitted of Charge Concerning a
Hungarian.

Kingston, Aug. 17.—Pte. Ralph Fish, of the 59th Battalion, at Barrisfield, was found not guilty to-day by Police Magistrate Farrell on a charge of attempting to break into the house of Vincent Oskey, Kingston Junction. The evidence showed that Oskey is a **Hungarian**, and had made remarks too

favorable to Britain's enemies. Fish was merely proceeding to thrash him.
