

MUST REMAIN IN CAMP

Austrian Told That Aliens Have No Standing in Canadian Courts.

Montreal, Aug. 18.—The application of Mihai Gusetu, an Austrian, for a writ of habeas corpus to be released from internment was denied by Mr. Justice McLennan, who, in a lengthy judgment, stated that the courts could not interfere in matters concerning the safety of the realm.

In the course of his judgment Mr. Justice McLennan pointed out that the subject of a country at war with Canada had no legal standing in the courts.
