

CALL HAS COME TO GREEKS IN AMERICA

Reservists in Ottawa Will Report
at Once to Their Consul in
Montreal.

Through the columns of a Greek paper, published in New York, 20 classes of Greeks are called to the colors. These classes include the recruits of 1892 to 1914. The recruits of 1912-13 and 14, who have served but three months in the Greek army, are called out that they may at once get into training and be ready for eventualities. The article states that Greek reservists must report to the nearest consul within six days after receiving the call. The nearest Greek consul for the local Greeks will be through Montreal. It was stated this morning that 1,000 Greeks in Montreal will leave for Greece in a short time. Ottawa has about 250 Greeks, but no special call has been received save through the columns of the New York paper.
