The censorship on foreign mail matter addressed to Canadian newspapers, now enforced by Ottawa, is foolish. From one end of Canada to the other the newspapers have shown greater discretion in the daily presentation of war news and views to the people than the men who imposed the censorship.

If the government is anxious to do something further in the way of blocking the designs of the enemy, why not check the business of smuggling enemy aliens from Canada into the United States.
