

WOMAN ATTEMPTS TO JOIN HER HUSBAND IN INTERNMENT CAMP

Demanding the restoration of her husband or her own internment, an Austrian woman from Ontario arrived at the internment camp here on Thursday and caused considerable embarrassment among the authorities there by refusing to take herself away. She had a seven year old child with her on the expedition.

The husband, it appears, had given some trouble in the past and was interned with other prisoners in Brandon. His wife was receiving a monthly allowance from the Government.

Latterly, however, she tired of living alone in Ontario and decided to undertake an expedition with the object of joining her interned lesser half. The officers at the camp did not take very kindly to this proposal, and the lady eventually left after some persuasion had been exerted. She is being looked after by the city pending a decision as to her disposal.
