Two More U.S. Papers Placed Under the Ban

Ottawa, Oct. 29.—The Postoffice Department has placed under the ban two more United States papers, *The Narodni List*, a Croatian daily, paper published in New York, and *The Irish Voice*, a Chicago weekly. Both papers are debarred the use of the mails, and any person found having them in his possession is liable to a fine of \$5,000 or five years' imprisonment.
