

# MAY ATTACK CANADA AT SEVERAL POINTS

## SEVERAL GREAT LAKE CITIES SPECIFIED IN REPORTS TO BRITISH EMBASSY.

(Canadian Press Despatch.)

New York, Nov. 22.—The Evening World this afternoon published the following:

"Washington, Nov. 22.—Cleveland, Buffalo, Toledo, Detroit and other Great Lakes cities have been specified in reports to the British Embassy as points from which an attack on Canada was to be launched by German reservists, the British Embassy said to-day.

"So far, however, nothing has been discovered to warrant a protest to this Government, it was said."

## FERRETING AT CLEVELAND.

### Seek Plotters Against the Munition Industries.

Cleveland, Ohio, Nov. 22.—Cleveland, where millions of dollars' worth of munitions have been made for the allies, has become the centre of activities to ferret out alleged plotters. To-day many secret conferences between secret service men and various city and county officials were held. One official turned over to the Federal men letters involving a representative of a foreign Government in plots to cripple Cleveland factories.

Chemicals and a regular laboratory were found by Berea police in the quarters of a German house painter, who fled the town Saturday night, following an assault on a young man who had meddled with his chemical experiments. Berea officials think he was a German spy.
