

An interesting discovery has been made in connection with the Patriotic Fund subscriptions in Ontario. The largest per capita contributions have been made in those localities where the population is largely German. Berlin, for instance, has to its credit a subscription of \$2.50 for each person, as compared with \$1.28 in Toronto, which is considered to be the most English city in Canada. Enlistment in the German settlements has also been in accord. However, this is largely in Ontario. In Western Canada the German settlements have not made as good a showing as those in Ontario.—Perth Courier.
