

Not Non-Suited Though An Alien

TORONTO, Nov. 27—Mr. Justice Middleton has refused application of the Grand Trunk railway for dismissal of a case for damages brought against the railway by Theodore Slozchuk, an alien enemy. Slozchuk, who came to Canada from Austria in July, 1914, had his leg broken soon afterwards while working at a bridge on the Grand Trunk east of Toronto, and was for ten weeks in Oshawa hospital.
