

Threatens Consul's Life.

Kingston, Dec. 2.—Wm. Rosko, a German prisoner, released on parole from ~~Fort Henry~~, declares that many of the prisoners at the fort have concealed knives, and that one, Joseph Schmidt, has made a threat that he will take the life of the United States Consul, F. S. S. Johnston, of this city, the first chance he gets. It is alleged that he wishes to take revenge because Mr. Johnston, who acts as German Consul, did not secure his release, for which there is no pretext. Rosko, who is dying of tuberculosis, was released that he might go to Calgary to live with his brother.
