

PETER MORTENSEN IS OUT OF ONE JAIL BUT IS IN ANOTHER

Deported From Michigan and Arrested by Canadian Police

Nils Peter Mortensen, the Dane, who took four Austrians across the river from Point Aux Pins to the Michigan side last August 4, was arrested Sat-

urday by the Canadian authorities, and is now in the jail awaiting trial.

Mortensen, who was caught red-handed by the Michigan authorities last August, was given a jail sentence at their hands, and was only released last Saturday. He was immediately deported by the United States Immigration Department, and when he stepped off the ferry on this side of the river was again arrested.

He was taken before Magistrate Mackay on a charge of aiding alien enemies to escape, and was remanded until Dec. 24. The four Austrians, who will be required as witnesses in the case, are now at the concentration camp at Kapuskasing, where they were sent after being returned by the United States authorities in August.
