

IMPOSING ARRAY OF NAMES IN NEW NATURALIZATION LIST

Ottawa, Jan. 10.—The Secretary of State issued Saturday a list of those to whom Imperial naturalization papers have been issued under the new Naturalization Act, up to December 31. The list contains an imposing array of prominent Canadians, who are of alien birth. The list of those who were formerly naturalized, but have now taken out Imperial naturalization papers is headed by Sir George Perley, acting High Commissioner for Canada. The second name is Canada's new baron, Sir Thomas Shaughnessy. Others in the list are: Sir William Van Horne, E. J. Chamberlin, President of the Grand Trunk Railway; Howard G. Kelly, vice-president of the Grand Trunk; Dr. E. G. Deville, surveyor-general for Canada; C. F. Sise, Jr., manager of the Bell Telephone Company; P. F. Sise, vice-president and general manager of the Northern Electric Co.; C. N. Candee, Toronto, vice-president of the Gutta Percha Rubber Co.; John L. Englehart, chairman Temiskaming and Northern Ontario Railway Co.; B. L. Baldwinson, Deputy Provincial Secretary of Manitoba; and Gustav Heidman, private secretary of Hon. J. D. Hazen.
