at Bankhead, was examined by Supt
Clarke last week and ordered interned until the end of the war.

and boasted that he had received a communication from the Austrian consulate at Seattle offering him \$1,500 to blow up the Stony creek bridge on the C.P.R. main line. Three witnesses testified to having heard him make this statement. Lovak bore an excellent reputation

as a miner and a mind-his-ownbusiness fellow until booze loosened his tongue. He has nearly \$3,-000 to his credit in the local bank.
