

German-Canadian Brigade?

That a brigade of Canadians of German descent be raised to fight for Canada at the front is the suggestion which has been made to the Minister of Militia and is now being considered by him. There are at present numbers of such men among the ranks of Canadian soldiers at the front, and they have done splendid service. The chief intelligence officer with the first contingent is a German-Canadian whose father was a German army officer and whose mother was the daughter of an Austrian general, with three brothers fighting in the Austrian ranks to-day. Her son in the Canadian arm has already been decorated for good service.
