

LOCOMOTIVE EMPLOYEES ASKING FOR DISMISSAL OF ALL ENEMY WORKERS

Kingston, Ont., Feb. 7.—A petition has been put in circulation at the Canadian Locomotive Works, which is working night and day on war munitions, asking for the dismissal or retirement of every German, Austrian and Hungarian now employed. There are thirty-six foreigners on the pay roll. Practically every man has signed the petition. The plant now has 1,200 men on its pay roll. Petition comes as a result of burning of Parliament Buildings at Ottawa.
