

# ALL ALIEN ENEMIES DISMISSED AT CALGARY

Returned Soldiers Will be Em-  
ployed Wherever Possible  
in Their Stead

Calgary, Alb., Feb. 14.—At a meeting of the City Council Saturday, at which Brigadier-General Cruikshank was present, a motion was passed to the effect that the council had confidence in the military authorities. In case of any further trouble, should civilians interfere, the General said he would call on the magistrate to ask them to disperse.

All civic employes of alien nationality were ordered immediately dismissed and all foreigners born in enemy countries employed in the street railway department were laid off by order of Commissioner Graves this morning.

A rider was added to the motion to the effect that returned soldiers be employed where possible in the places of the discharged men.
