

ARREST ALLEGED SPY

Held by Montreal Authorities to Give Account of Himself

MONTREAL, Feb. 18.—A man whom the military authorities believe to be a German and perhaps a spy, was brought into Montreal from the works at Rigaud, Que., of the Canadian Curtis & Harvey plant. The man, who was heavily manacled, protests vehemently that he is an Italian, but the authorities are not satisfied with his accounting of himself. His name is being withheld pending further investigation.
