

OPPOSED TO GERMANS IN CANADA'S CIVIL SERVICE

Port Hope Mass Meeting Takes an Emphatic Stand

A copy of the following resolution, passed unanimously by a mass meeting held in Port Hope, has been forwarded to Sir Robert Borden: "That this mass meeting of the people of Port Hope, assembled for the purpose of promoting local recruiting of soldiers for the Canadian Overseas forces, desires to express its earnest disapproval of the employment of persons of German birth, whether naturalized or otherwise, in positions of authority or influence in the public service of Canada," believing that the employment of such is detrimental to the interests of the country and likely to prove in the outcome a serious injury to Canadian civic and military efficiency."
