Interned Germans Attempted Escape. Halifax, N.S., Feb. 21.—On Friday night three of the German prisoners

at the citadel attempted to escape. They got into the moat and one of the three by means of a rope succeeded in getting out. The other two were unable to manage, however, and not wanting to go without them the first one gave himself up and told the guards about his two comrades still in the most. All three were hastily returned.
