

BERLIN COUNCIL ASKS GERMANS TO REGISTER

Aliens of Waterloo Respond to City's Request With a Rush

Berlin, Dec. 28.—The third request of the City Council for the establishment of a court for the registration of aliens of enemy birth has been complied with by the Department of Justice. Notices were distributed throughout Berlin, Waterloo and vicinity, requesting all aliens of German, Austrian and Hungarian birth to register. Sixty responded Saturday, and a rush is expected during this week. Chief of Police O'Neill has been appointed Registrar and is being assisted by members of the Dominion Police staff.
