

# WAR OFFICE HAS LIST OF THE PRISONERS

## That Are In Germany—Gerard Secures Names of Kingston Men.

American Consul F. S. S. Johnson has received word from Ambassador Gerard at Berlin, Germany, that the list of Kingston men who are prisoners-of-war in German camps has been submitted to London. The application for the list has been made to the British War Office through Ambassador W. H. Page, and Mr. Johnson expects to receive the names in the near future. Future consignments of goods to the prisoners can be based on this list, and a correspondence kept up as to the needs that are most pressing.

Mr. Johnson will despatch the next shipment on March 20th, and is hopeful of receiving the sum of \$50 by subscriptions before that date. Citizens have been donating liberally in the last two weeks to the fund and the additional amount should come in rapidly.
