*For some months past it has been made clear that German agents have been carrying on a more or less well organized campaign to inflict injury upon the property of Canadians. There have been attempts to blow up bridges, and factories engaged in the manufacture of munitions, and only a couple of days ago two German citizens, acting as the agents of another German in Detroit, were sent to penitentiary for blowing up a Canadian plant. Realizing the danger, the Toronto Electric Light Company has redoubled its ordinary precautions to protect its lines from Niagara Falls to Toronto. It has established patrols, excluded aliens from its employ, and what with its steam reserve plant and storage batteries in Toronto, has little expectation that the enemy will be able to interrupt its service.
